Dr. Catherine Metayer is an Adjunct Professor at the University of California, Berkeley, School of Public Health, Division of Epidemiology and Epidemiology/Biostatistics. Her specialty includes the epidemiology of childhood cancers and exposure science, and is the current director of CIRCLE. Circle's mission is to discover how environmental exposures and genetics interact to cause childhood leukemia in an effort to prevent the disease.
